6.1 Fitset Ninja - Booked for May 15, 2025 Fitset Ninja has been booked and paid for for May 15th. This event will become a component of our annual Wellness Day. All student will participate. The event was sponsored by parent council.

6.2 Alberta Education Assurance Survey - closes March 21 *The survey was sent out* via email to all parents of students in grades 4-8. At the time of the meeting about 9 parent surveys had been completed. Students in grades 4-8 also completed the survey at school. All teachers were also completing the survey.

6.3 Extra Curricular Events - basketball, floor hockey, badminton Norwood had a very successful basketball season. Four teams participated in the WRPS grade 4-6 tournament. Norwood successfully hosted the grade 6 girls for this. Our junior high boys team won the bronze medal in the LDAA league. Norwood entered 3 teams in the WRPS grades 4-6 floor hockey tournament. Our junior high students will be participating in the LDAA badminton tournaments in April.

All grade 6 parents have received information in the fall and spring regarding PAT testing.
