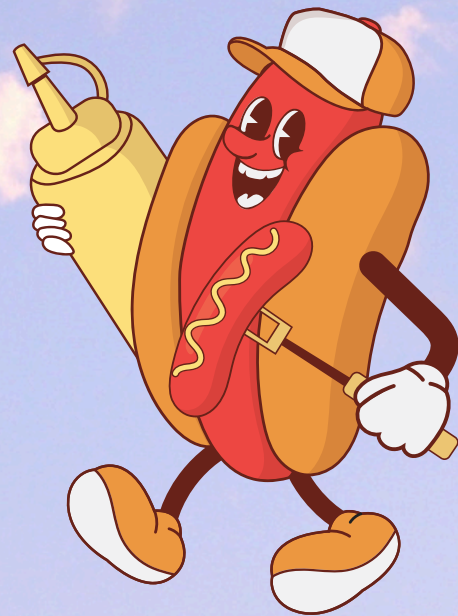
From 12:15 - 1:15, our amazing parent council is hosting a school BBQ. See you there!

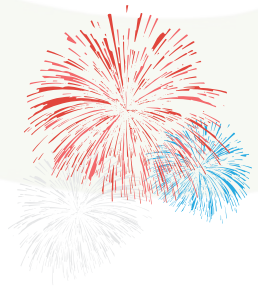
